Lift Up Your Hearts

As our crèche figures and Christmas decorations are safely packed away, it's important that we keep the image of the Christ child close to us all year long. God became one of us and entered into our world in the same way we all do: as a defenseless child. As Catholics it remains our duty to give a faithful witness to the dignity of all human life.

January 22 (this coming Saturday) marks the 38th anniversary of the Supreme Court's historic 1973 decision in *Roe v. Wade*, clearing the way for states to legalize abortion. Since that date over 45 million legal abortions have been performed in our nation. While that number is staggering, I fear that many Catholics have grown indifferent to the grave moral evil that persists in our midst.

Our bishops have called us to observe this infamous date as a day of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion and of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life. I ask you to be mindful of this by offering up some sacrifice on this day as you would during Lent. Beyond this observance all of us are called to profess the Gospel of Life.

Each year Americans of all faiths march on Washington as a peaceful demonstration of our convictions that our government is bound to protect all innocent life. This year the March for Life will take place on Monday, January 24. Their website (www.marchforlife.org) provides detailed information for the event and is an excellent resource for better acquainting yourself with the issues.

IRA Rollover Reinstate for 2010 & 2011 - Through passage of a bipartisan tax compromise which was signed into law by Present Obama on Friday, Dec 17, 2010: Individuals over 70 1/2 years of age may once again make direct distributions from their Individual Retirement Accounts (IRAs) to charities, parishes, schools, etc of up to \$100,000 per year. A special provision allows interested donors to make distribution that will be treated as being made in 2010 if completed by an extension date of January 31, 2011. Please instruct your IRA custodian (broker, bank, etc.) to transfer funds directly to your parish by this deadline to escape taxation of funds withdrawn from your IRA for this purpose. It may be too late this year (2010) to direct your minimum distribution as a gift. However, you may include your minimum distribution or any amount up to \$100,000 per person in next year's giving by making your 2011 IRA donation by December 31, 2011.
