Lift Up Your Hearts

As I have begun to discuss some of the changes in the Mass which we will expect later this year, some people have asked me: **What exactly is changing?**

The structure of the Mass, that is, the actions of the priest, the posture of the people (standing, kneeling, sitting), and all of our ritual actions will remain as they are now. The English translation of the prayers of the Mass which have been revised to more closely reflect the Latin texts. Some of the prayers which we recite from memory will need to be relearned, such as the *Glory to God in the Highest*, the *Creed*, and the response to our familiar invitation to prayer, *The Lord be with you*, which will soon be: *And with your spirit*.

The language which we use in prayer in has always tended to be more formal than the speech we use in ordinary conversation, in order to set apart our time at worship from our every day lives. In addition to using a more particular or sacred mode of speech, the translators have been very diligent in maintaining the rich references to the Scriptures which are found in the liturgy and now often un-noticed. This Fall, as we prepare for and begin to pray using the new translation, I will take the time to offer some insight into the particular changes you will notice.



At all of the Masses last weekend, during the homily, I introduced two important questions to our entire parish: What do you want our parish to be? What is God asking us to be in the midst of our communities? I consider these to be two very important, foundational questions which our whole parish needs to reflect on. There might be many ideas and needs, and many answers that come quickly to mind. As we begin our second century, I very believe very firmly that it is an opportunity for us to strengthen our identity as individual Catholics and Christians, and to strengthen our identity as a parish.

The Lord has assured his Church that He has sent us His Holy Spirit to direct and strengthen us, and even to offer our prayers to the Father when we don't know how or for what we should pray. This week I invite all of our parishioners to join with me in praying daily for the Holy Spirit's guidance and renewal for St. Raphael Parish.
